

BY-LAW NO. 29
A BY-LAW TO LICENSE TRANSIENT TRADERS

The Council of the Village of Chipman, under authority vested in it by the Municipalities Act, enacts as follows:

TITLE

1. This By-Law may be cited as the Transient Traders By-Law.

INTERPRETATION

2. In this By-Law;
 - (a) "transient trader" means:
 - (i) a person doing business in the Village who, not having resided in the municipality for at least three (3) months next preceding the time of the commencement by him of such business, offers goods or merchandise for sale and whether conducted by himself or his agent.
 - (ii) a person commencing any business whatsoever in the Village who has not been entered on the assessment roll for the then current year in respect of tax.
 - (b) "person" includes a body corporate and politic, and the heirs, executors, administrators or other legal representatives of a person.
3. Every transient trader shall pay to the Village Clerk a business tax of One Hundred (100.00) dollars before commencing in the Village.
4. Except as herein provided, no person, not being a resident or ratepayer of the Village shall carry on or engage in any business, industry, calling, profession or occupation within the Village unless he obtains a license therefore.
5. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized to grant to any person a license under the seal of the Village to carry on or engage in any business, industry, calling, profession or occupation within the Village upon payment of such person to the Village Clerk of a license fee, payable for such license.
6. The license fee payable under this Part shall be One Hundred (100.00) dollars.

7. A license issued under this By-Law shall continue in force for one year from the date of issue therefore.

No person who is

(a) an employee of a telephone or electric power company, who is required in the course of his duties to carry on his occupation temporarily within the Village;

(b) an insurance agent, broker or adjuster who is required to pay a license fee under the Provisions of the Insurance Act;

(c) a transient trader who has paid a business tax under Section 3: or

(d) a transient trader who sells perishable items,

shall be required to obtain a license under this Part.

Every person who violates any provision of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty not less than One Hundred (100.00) dollars and not exceeding Five Hundred (500.00) dollars.
