

BY LAW NO. 33

WINTER PARKING BY-LAW

INTERPRETATION

1. In this by-law, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) words which are defined in Section 1 of the Motor Vehicle Act 1955 have the meaning as so defined for the purposes of this by-law.

RESTRICTED PARKING

2. In the months of December, January, February and March, between the hours of midnight and seven o'clock in the forenoon of any day, no person shall park a vehicle unattended on any highway within Chipman Village limits.

IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES

3. A peace officer may remove and impound any vehicle which is found illegally parked on any highway, and no person shall take possession of a vehicle so removed or impounded until all costs and charges for, removal, care and storage of such vehicles have been paid.

PENALTIES

4. Any person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than fifty dollars.
5. This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.
