

The regular meeting of the Village of Chipman Council was called to order by Mayor Edward Farris at 7 PM on November 3, 2014. All Councillors were present; namely, Councillor Carol Boyd, Councillor Faith Kennedy, Councillor Robin Wasson and Councillor Keith West.

Moved by Councillor Robin Wasson and seconded by Councillor Keith West that minutes of the regular meeting of October 6, 2014 and special meetings of October 2, 24 and 29, 2014 be adopted as circulated. Motion carried.

Cpl. Villers gave the RCMP report for October. There were 11 calls within the Village of Chipman.

Mayor Farris attended several Regional Service Commission meetings. The proposed raise in tipping fees is now 1.50 instead of 10.

There was some trouble with the pump station beside the Heritage Centre. One pump had seized. It is up and running again.

Signs for Wegesegum Road and Northrup Drive are up.

Mayor Farris attended the Minlak Board meeting. They are selling tickets on a Christmas basket.

A letter was received from Grand Manan expressing condolences on death of the two teenagers in the community.

Oil has flowed into our lagoon at the treatment plant from a sewer drain. The source of the spill has been found. Environment has been contacted and is working with us on it.

Flushing has been done.

Fish & Game Club would like direction signs for their club at each end of Hillcrest Avenue.

There is a meeting on November 4, 2014 at 10 AM with Council of Canadians regarding opposition to the pipeline.

Councillor Robin Wasson stated some patching was done on Dufferin Avenue.

Maintenance has been done on the machines.

Jake Brake signs have been put up. They were supplied by J.D. Irving Limited.

Councillor Wasson is working on getting a crosswalk light at the mill crosswalk.

Councillor Wasson gave the Community Care report.

Santa Claus parade plans are underway.

Councillor Faith Kennedy attended EMO meetings on October 8 and October 29, 2014 regarding financing for a generator.

Councillor Kennedy attended the Community Action meeting, Library meeting, Festival meeting, pipeline open house and the QNCHC community advisory committee meeting.

Councillor Carol Boyd gave the W.G. Bishop Nursing Home report. There is no waiting list.

The pressure tank in the plant room at the arena was replaced.

Councillor Boyd gave the Chipman Outreach report. Their appreciation night is November 13, 2014 at 6:30 PM at the Fish & Game Club.

Councillor Boyd gave the website and building permit report. Bingo is going well but more volunteers are needed. There were 9 entries in the Halloween Home Decorating contest.

Councillor Keith West gave the Fire Department report for October. Two applications were received for new firemen.



Dog Park committee is still fund raising.


The next Growth Committee meeting is November 26, 2014 in Chipman.
